Certified Track Seal Application Agreement

For producers and artists submitting one intentional electronic music track for certification.

A clear agreement for participation in the Intentional Electro certification system. This practical template may be reviewed by legal counsel before publication or operational use.

1. Purpose of this document

This document confirms the applicant's wish to submit one track for the Intentional Electro Certified Track Seal. The Track Seal is granted to a specific piece of music, not automatically to the entire artist catalogue.

Core sentence: This track carries intention. I allow it to be reviewed, recognized and publicly verified.

2. What the producer submits

The applicant submits one track with enough context for the jury to understand the intention behind the music and the state it is designed to create.

- Artist / producer name
- Legal name or organisation name for internal administration
- Track title
- Private or public listening link
- Release date or planned release date
- Short intention statement: what the track is meant to create, open, release or move
- Short production context if relevant
- Links to artist profiles
- Confirmation that the applicant has the right to submit the track for certification

3. What the jury listens for

- Clear emotional or energetic intention
- Coherence between intention and production choices
- A felt movement or state created by the track
- Musical care, atmosphere and integrity
- Alignment with the Intentional Electro Manifesto
- A track identity that feels intentional, alive and culturally meaningful



4. What the producer receives if accepted

- Official Intentional Electro Certified Track Seal
- Digital seal files as PNG for online use
- Print-ready PNG files for offline use where suitable
- Public listing in the Certified Track Registry
- Certification link for verification
- QR code connected to the certification link
- A short certification statement for release notes, artist pages, Bandcamp, press texts or social media
- Possible consideration for curated playlists, editorial features or future Intentional Electro channels

5. Public registry and verification

The applicant agrees that, if certified, the artist name, track title, selected profile or release links, certification status and certification link may be listed in the Intentional Electro certification area. This allows listeners, curators, bookers and press contacts to verify the seal.

6. Free application period until the end of 2027

Applications and the review process are free until 31 December 2027. The certification itself is not presented as a purchased object. In later phases, a fee may be charged for application handling, jury review, renewal or administrative processing.

7. Use of the seal

- The seal may be used only after acceptance.
- The seal applies only to the certified track named in the application.
- The seal may not be used to imply that the full artist catalogue is certified unless separately confirmed.
- The applicant may use the provided PNG seal files online and offline.
- The applicant may not transfer the seal to another track, artist, label or release.

8. Duration, renewal and revocation

Track certification is connected to the specific track and its registry entry. Intentional Electro may remove or suspend a listing if the seal is misused, if rights information is materially false, or if the certified work is presented in a way that conflicts with the integrity of the certification system.

9. Applicant commitments

- I submit the track honestly and confirm that I have the right to submit it.
- I understand that the jury listens for intention, not popularity, label status or genre.
- I agree that acceptance is not guaranteed.
- I agree to use the seal only for the accepted track.
- I support the cultural purpose of Intentional Electro: more care, intention and emotional awareness in electronic music.

Can I resubmit the same track?

- A submitted track is reviewed as one specific work in its submitted form.
- If a track is not approved, the same track cannot normally be submitted again.
- Exceptions may be granted for good reason, such as a substantial rework, missing context, a submission error or an explicit invitation from the review team.
- This helps protect the value and clarity of the Track Seal.
